Enclosed are copies of a recent letter from Kathleen Kilpatrick (Virginia DHR) to David Paylor (Virginia DEQ) and our reply. Ms. Kilpatrick's letter includes a finding of "No Adverse Affect" to historic properties in the Columbia Forest Products situation here in Chatham, based on information provided to her by DEQ. Our reply details the very significant errors of fact contained in the DEQ information. As a result, we believe that the finding of "No Adverse Effect" is without factual basis and therefore erroneous.



