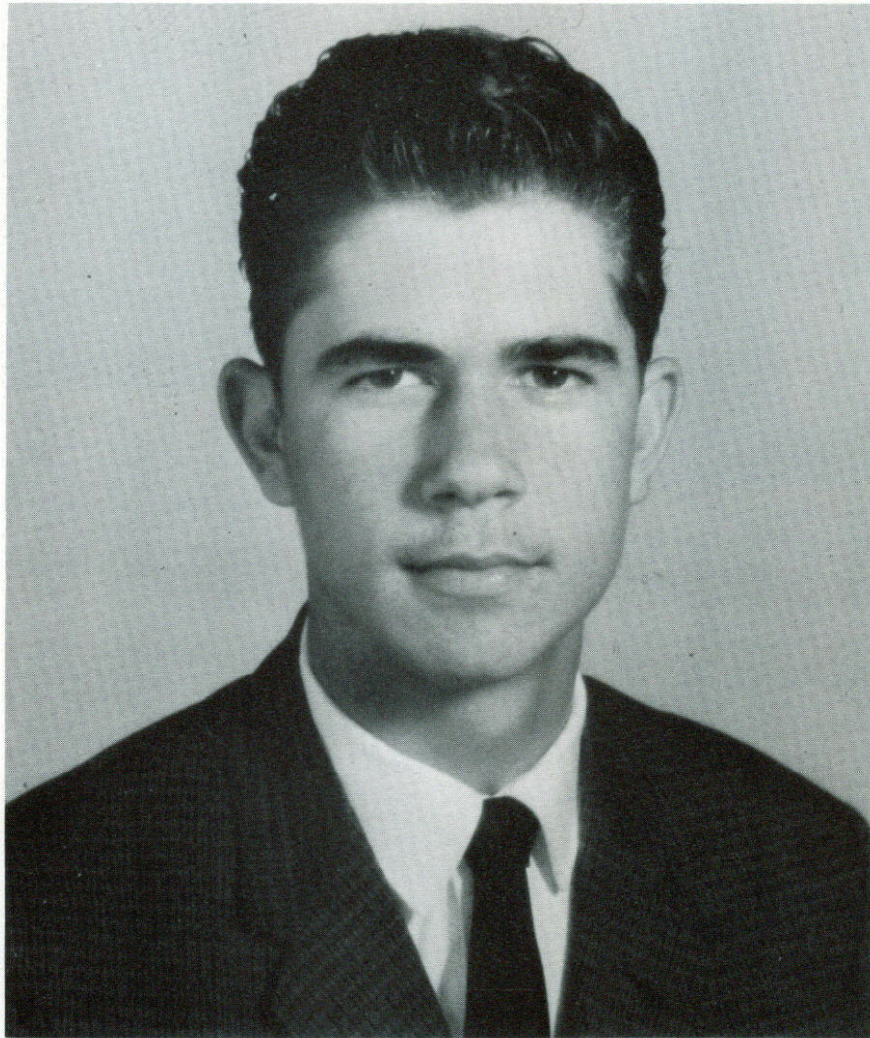


Doris Emerson measures Linda Snow's height before ordering caps and gowns for graduation.

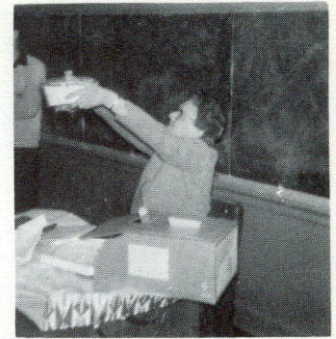
Senior Activities
